- Vocal cord paralysis
 Hoarseness
- Vocal Cord nodules or polyps
- Dysphonia
- Laryngectomies voice swallowing

Speech/Language

- Apraxia
 Inability to initiate or sequence movements
 for speech
- Articulation
 Inability to make correct sounds
- Aphasia
 Inability to attach meaning to language
 (spoken, printed number or gestures)
 due to brain injury
- Dysarthria
 Speech disorders due to paralysis, weakness, or in coordination of speech muscles

Swallowing

- Inability to swallow correctly
